Why should I apply?

Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi's mission aims to support and promote the professional and personal development of the many educational audiences it serves, including trainees. It serves as a medical campus that seamlessly combines high performance architecture with sophisticated advanced technologies and world-class care, creating one of the most advanced patient-centered hospitals in the world. Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi's residency and fellowship training programs offer aspiring doctors valuable exposure to the medical field in a setting that is unparalleled in the region.

What are the eligibility criteria?

Applicants for Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi's residency and fellowship training programs must meet the eligibility criteria listed below.

1. Cumulative medical school Grade Point Average (GPA) of greater than or equal to 3.0 (On a 4.0 point scale), or its equivalent.
2. Fulfilment of MEAD criteria as per the Abu Dhabi Department of Health.
3. Fulfillment of licensure requirements set forth by the Abu Dhabi Department of Health. For more information please visit <https://www.doh.gov.ae/en/>

Application prioritization is given to applicants who demonstrate the following:

1. Excellent Academic Records
2. Excellent performance on USMLE steps 1 & 2 Clinical Knowledge, or equivalent medical exams.
3. Proof of English language proficiency.
 - ✓ TOEFL: a minimum score of 80 on the internet-based exam or 550 on the paper exam;
OR
 - ✓ IELTS: a minimum score of 6.5 on the academic test.

Note:

- Eligibility criteria may change without prior notice.
- Specific specialty criteria may apply.

How do I apply?

In order to apply, you must first ensure that you meet the eligibility criteria listed in the previous section.

You must prepare the documents outlined by the Abu Dhabi Department of Health, which are updated on an annual basis. The list of required documents can be accessed online: <https://www.doh.gov.ae/en/>

Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi is required to follow the Abu Dhabi Residency and Fellowship Program Application and Match, MEAD. The application process is outlined as follows:

- Eligible applicants must register and pass the Residency Entrance Examination as conducted by UAE University Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences (Residency applicants).
- Eligible applicants use the MEAD application to apply for residency and fellowship training programs in Abu Dhabi.

When should I apply?

The MEAD application form is made available in February each year for a period of two months.

Log into the Abu Dhabi Department of Health website by the end of the current year for specific exam entry dates and entry requirements. The link to the online application will only be available during the application submission period via the Abu Dhabi Department of Health website.
